## WHAT NOT TO BRING

In order to maintain the intended atmosphere at New Life Camp, please follow these rules when packing. Campers may not use tobacco, liquor or illegal drugs. Girls and guys please wear modest apparel. (Refrain from shorts shorter than finger tip length. No short T-shirts are allowed. Tank tops must have 2 inches at the shoulder.) We ask that no one wear clothing which depicts musical groups. ## LOST AND FOUND

Please mark all clothing. Lost items not requested in 30 days will be given away. Campers must pay \$3.00 for postage and handling on all items that have to be mailed.

## REGISTRATION CHECKLIST:

- Read each item carefully and check off as you do each step.
- Fill in camp registration form completely, indicating your first, second and third choice of weeks. No camper can come for more than one week during the summer.
- Fill in the medical form completely and have it notarized.
- Mail those 2 forms with the registration fee to New Life Camp as quickly as possible. There must be a postmark date on the registration envelope.
- When we receive your registration, we will enter your child into one of your preferred weeks. If your first choice is full, we will contact you immediately to tell you.
- We will send out your confirmation card as soon as possible.
- Please mark your calendar with your camp week and keep your all this information which will answer your questions later.
- Please send back to New Life Camp your confirmation card with your final payment as soon as possible. If your child is doing lessons for a 1/2 price week at overnight camp and is not finished but is expecting to finish, send the 1/2 price amount.
- Whether your child is a returning camper or a first time camper, all will be treated the same. **FIRST COME, FIRST SERVED.**
- If you have checked off the above, mail your registration right away. We hope to see you this summer!
